## **Instructions for Installation**

First, of all we thank you for the order of our book. We hope that you will discover inside some valuable information that will provide more insights into the mysterious crystal skulls.

This document contains all the instructions how to setup your book and be able to read it. If you follow the step-by-step pattern you will find that it is very easy to be able to read the e-book. Also you have the option to print this book at any time (please see inside of the e-book the section toward the back “How to Read this Book” for suggestions of printing your book).

### **1.1 Requirements to read the E-book (PDF File):**

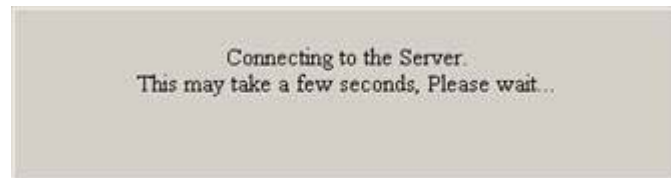
- Intel Pentium or any compatible processor.
- Microsoft Windows 95, 98, ME, Windows NT 4.0 (SP4, SP5, SP6), Windows 2000, and Windows XP.
- For Mac Users: If you have a Apple Macintosh Computer, we have been able to test our e-book with customers who use Virtual PC on a Mac and it will work. So if you have this Windows emulation program running on OS System X (possible 9 as well), and have a connection to the internet, you can read our e-book
- Adobe Acrobat or Acrobat Reader 5.0 or higher.
- CD-ROM, DVD-ROM or CD-RW drive.

### **1.2 Files contained on the Crystal Skull Explorer CD:**

- CSExplorer-ebook.exe (the actual crystal skull e-book)
- AdbeRdr60\_enu\_full.exe (Adobe Reader® 6.0-for Windows 2000/ME/NT/XP)
- rp505enu.exe (Adobe Reader®5.1, Windows 95/98)
- Read1st.txt (file to explain first steps to do)
- instructions.pdf (instructions how to install your e-book, PDF file)
- troubleshooting.pdf (steps to take if you have problems with your e-book)

## 2. 1 Installation Steps

- 1) First install Adobe Reader® or Adobe Acrobat® if not already installed on your computer (you must have release 5.0 or higher). We have included Adobe Reader® 6.0 on this CD for your convenience (just click on it and it will self install)
- 2) You can either read the book from the CD itself or you can create a directory on your computer (example: c:/csexplorer) and read the book from your hard drive. We have found that the book in general will read faster if you copy it to your hard drive. The only file you need to copy to your computer, if you decide to go this route is CSExplorerer-ebook.exe.
- 3) Run the file CSExplorerer-ebook.exe to open your book. When you begin this program, you will see the window below come up:



This message means that the program is calling to our validation server through Digilox, the company we have used to ensure that you have a legal copy of the book. You will see this message possibly twice. Once your copy has been validated, Adobe Reader or Acrobat will be executed and the copy of your book is ready to be read. At this point, you can disconnect from the internet.

**(Please Note -- IMPORTANT:** In order to be able to read your Crystal Skull e-book, you must be connected to the internet before you open it or run the file **only for the first time**. Click CSExplorerer-ebook.exe. Once your e-book has opened into Adobe Acrobat or Reader, you can disconnect from the internet. Thereafter, when you click on your e-book, it will just open up in Adobe Reader/Acrobat. The exception to this rule is if you decide to relocate your e-book. Please read that section which follows later in this document.)

## Reading Tips

**Page Links:** We have set up within your e-book what Adobe calls Page Links, that if you click upon this link, it will take you to another page within your e-book. These links may be visible or invisible. You will know that you are over a Page Link because your cursor will change into a hand with the index finger pointing straight out. The visible page links that exist are either in the Table of Contents (certain parts of the Titles surrounded by a dashed red line) or see XXXX (referring to a chapter or section in the book) that will show up in Blue. There are some invisible links we included in the Table of Contents Pages so you can go directly to this page. Also most listings in the Table of Contents are the same as what is listed under the Bookmarks Tab.

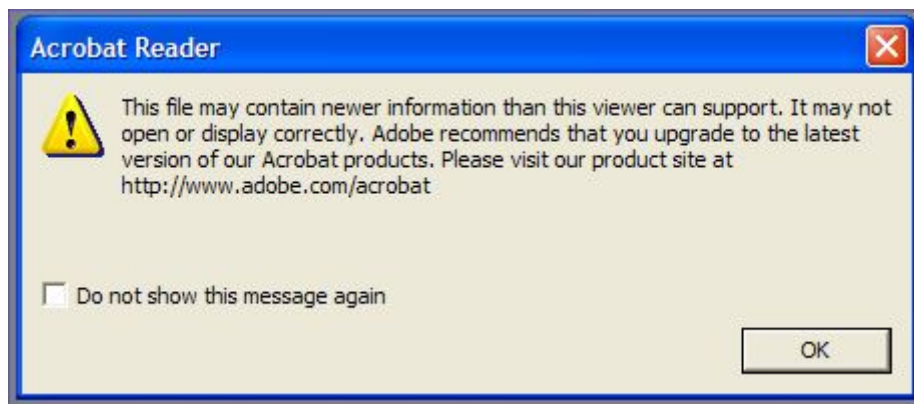
*(Please Note: Again all web sites addresses that are shown in blue will activate your web browser when you click on them and take you to that website if you are connected to the internet. The cursor will change to a hand with an index finger pointing out and the letter "W" over the hand.)*

**Best Way to View the E-book Pages:** For viewing the pages, you shouldn't be afraid to adjust the size of the page image. This control is seen near the top of the tool bars and is shown as a percentage (100% normally) with a "-" {decreasing} and "+" {increasing} clickable button next to this percentage size. For readability of the pages within this e-book we have found for Adobe Reader 5, 150-158% is best and also good for the pictures. In Adobe Reader 6, 125% is usually the best. Please feel free to use this control to view the pages (and especially the pictures) in a pleasing way and experiment with the right size that works for you.

*(Reminder: If you have a LCD display or Notebook computer, remember to use Cool Type. Read the section in our e-book entitled: HOW TO READ THIS BOOK, which explains how to set up this setting.)*

( Note -- For users of Version 5, Acrobat or Reader: Because our e-book was created in Acrobat 6, there is a message window you may see first, before you can view your e-book. Below is what this windows looks like:



You can choose to go to the Adobe Acrobat website and download for free the program, Adobe Acrobat Reader 6 or you can click on the checkbox at the bottom so this warning does not come up again when you view your e-book.

## Printing your E-book

You are permitted to print the pages out of your e-book. You can request individual or a specific range of pages. You may notice that when you are viewing your e-book in Adobe Reader® or Acrobat® that the Main Menu of Options (such as File and Edit, etc ...) is not present. Normally people will print a document by selecting the Print option under the File Menu. Do not be concerned about this. Near the top you will see an icon that looks like a “Printer”. All you have to do to print the pages is just click on this icon and then follow the procedure you normally do for your printer.

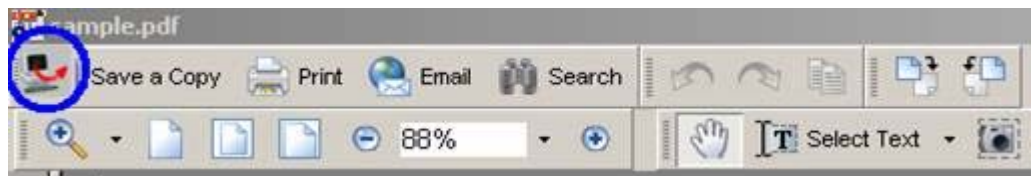
Again, we recommend that you print out the portions of your book that you wish to currently read, as there can be intermittent problems accessing the internet at times, which can prevent you from opening up your book.

**(Special Notice:** If you have Adobe Acrobat Professional 6, we have noticed that the print button in Acrobat is also disabled. To print your e-book properly, click the right mouse button anywhere on the contents of the e-book itself, and a menu will pop up. Select the Print option and then specify which pages to print. Also in this menu is the ability to move to the Next or Previous Pages.)

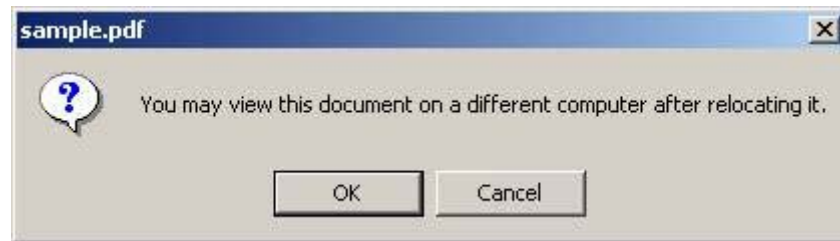
## Relocating your E-book if you'd like to view it on a different computer

The protected e-book can be opened only on one machine. If you want to open the e-book on another machine you must relocate the e-book on the first machine.

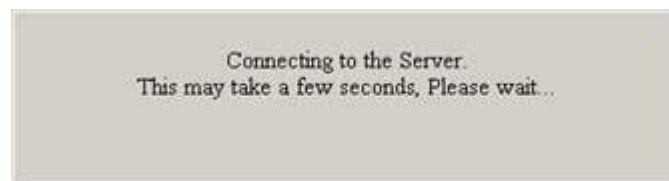
To relocate your e-book, you will see a button with the tool tip stating “Relocate this document”. This icon will appear on the top left corner of your e-book (Highlighted with a blue circle below)



If you click the relocation button (circled in blue) the following screen will appear.



Next click on the OK button to relocated your e-book to another computer. The following response will appear on your screen indicating that your ebook is connecting to the Validation server so that this servers records that you are moving your book to another computer.



The validation server will authenticate the protected ebook and if the authentication is successful the following screen will appear.



Once the above screen appears you can open the protected ebook on another machine.

If the authentication fails, relocation cannot be done and the following screen will appear.



The reason for getting an error while relocation can be related to a problem with your authentication after you opened your e-book. Please contact us directly if you are receiving this problem or consult our Trouble Shooting document.

**(Please Note:** If you decide to relocate your e-book, in order to validate your e-book on the other computer, you must be connected to the internet for the first time only. This then sets up the validation procedure for your e-book on the new computer. Again, after this initial validation process, the e-book will open up in the Adobe software.)

If other **error messages** appear, please refer to the Troubleshooting file on this CD.
