Instructions for Use and Installation

First, of all we thank you for the order of our book. We hope that you will discover inside some valuable information that will provide more insights into the mysterious crystal skulls.

This document contains all the instructions how to setup your book and be able to read it. If you follow the step-by-step pattern you will find that it is very easy! Also you have the option to print this book at any time (please see inside of the e-book the section toward the back "How to Read this Book" for suggestions on printing your book).

1.1 Requirements to read the E-book (PDF File):

- Intel Pentium or any compatible processor.
- Microsoft Windows 95, 98, ME, Windows NT 4.0 (SP4, SP5, SP6), Windows 2000, and Windows XP.
- Adobe Acrobat or Acrobat Reader 5.0 or higher.
- CD-ROM, DVD-ROM or CD-RW drive (for the CD version only).
- Floppy Disk Drive for special 1.44 mb Floppy Disk (mailed to you)

1.2 Files contained on the Crystal Skull Explorer CD:

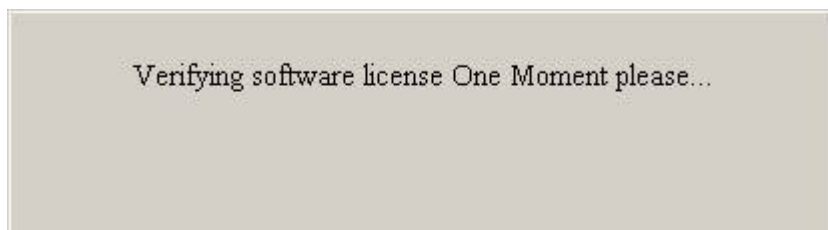
- CSExplorer-ebook.exe (the actual crystal skull e-book)
- AdbeRdr60_enu_full.exe (Adobe Reader® 6.0-for Windows 2000/ME/NT/XP)
- rp505enu.exe (Adobe Reader®5.1, Windows 95/98)
- Read1st.txt (file to explain first steps to do)
- instructions.pdf (instructions how to install your e-book, PDF file)
- troubleshooting.pdf (steps to take if you have problems with your e-book)

2. 1 Installation Steps

- 1) First install Adobe Reader® or Adobe Acrobat® if not already installed on your computer (you must have release 5.0 or higher). The reader is on this CD-if you need it- just click on *AdbRdr60_enu_full*.
- 2) Next copy the file CSExplorer-ebook.exe to your hard drive from the CD (perhaps setup a folder on your computer called c:/csexplorer). The e-book will not work properly from the CD.
- 3) Run the file CSExplorer-ebook.exe to open your book. When you begin this program, you will see the window below come up:



This is the request to insert the floppy diskette we sent to you. Digilox is the name of the company which has helped us to prepare our protection system for your e-book. ***It is suggested*** to not put the Digilox floppy into your drive until this screen appears. After placing the floppy into the floppy drive, click on the "OK" button. It will take a few moments for the e-book protection system to validate you have a legal copy. The following window will appear during the validation process:



After the validation of your e-book is complete, you will be able to view the e-book in Adobe Reader® or Acrobat®. When you want to read your e-book in the future, you will no longer have to insert the floppy disk, as long as the e-book stays on the same computer you just installed it upon. **However:** If in the future you decide to relocate your e-book to another computer, you will need the floppy diskette we sent you to do so (Relocation is discussed later in this document). So please place your floppy diskette in a safe place as this diskette cannot be copied or backed up.

Reading Tips

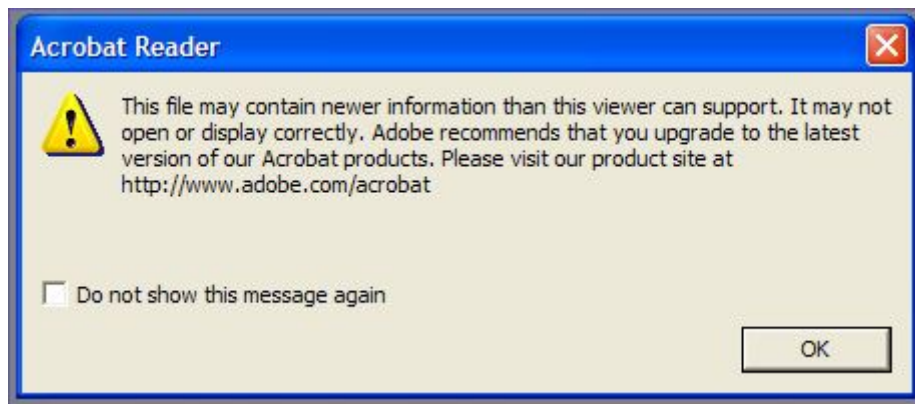
Page Links: We have set up within your e-book what Adobe calls Page Links, that if you click upon this link, it will take you to another page within your e-book. These links may be visible or invisible. You will know that you are over a Page Link because your cursor will change into a hand with the index finger pointing straight out. The visible page links that exist are either in the Table of Contents (certain parts of the Titles surrounded by a dashed red line) or see XXXX (referring to a chapter or section in the book) that will show up in Blue. There are some invisible links we included in the Table of Contents Pages so you can go directly to this page. Also most listings in the Table of Contents are the same as what is listed under the Bookmarks Tab.

(Please Note: Again all web sites addresses that are shown in blue will activate your web browser when you click on them and take you to that website if you are connected to the internet. The cursor will change to a hand with an index finger pointing out and the letter "W" over the hand.)

Best Way to View the E-book Pages: For viewing the pages, you shouldn't be afraid to adjust the size of the page image. This control is seen near the top of the tool bars and is shown as a percentage (100% normally) with a "-" {decreasing} and "+" {increasing} clickable button next to this percentage size. For readability of the pages within this e-book we have found for Adobe Reader 5, 150-158% is best and also good for the pictures. In Adobe Reader 6, 125% is usually the best. Please feel free to use this control to view the pages (and especially the pictures) in a pleasing way and experiment with the right size that works for you.

(Reminder: If you have a LCD display or Notebook computer, remember to use Cool Type. Read the section in our e-book entitled: HOW TO READ THIS BOOK, which explains how to set up this setting.)

(Note -- For users of Version 5, Acrobat or Reader: Because our e-book was created in Acrobat 6, there is a message window you may see first, before you can view your e-book. Below is what this windows looks like:



You can choose to go to the Adobe Acrobat website and download for free the program, Adobe Acrobat Reader 6 or you can click on the checkbox at the bottom so this warning does not come up again when you view your e-book.

Printing your E-book

You are permitted to print the pages out of your e-book. You can request individual or a specific range of pages. You may notice that when you are viewing your e-book in Adobe Reader® or Acrobat® that the Main Menu of Options (such as File and Edit, etc ...) is not present. Normally people will print a document by selecting the Print option under the File Menu. Do not be concerned about this. Near the top you will see an icon that looks like a “Printer”. All you have to do to print the pages is just click on this icon and then follow the procedure you normally do for your printer.

Again, we recommend that you print out the portions of your book that you wish to currently read, as there can be intermittent problems accessing the internet at times, which can prevent you from opening up your book.

(**Special Notice:** If you have Adobe Acrobat Professional 6, we have noticed that the print button in Acrobat is also disabled. To print your e-book properly, click the right mouse button anywhere on the contents of the e-book itself, and a menu will pop up. Select the Print option and then specify which pages to print. Also in this menu is the ability to move to the Next or Previous Pages.)

Relocating your E-book if you'd like to view it on a different computer

The protected ebook can be opened only on one machine. If you want to open the ebook on another machine you must relocate the ebook on the first machine.

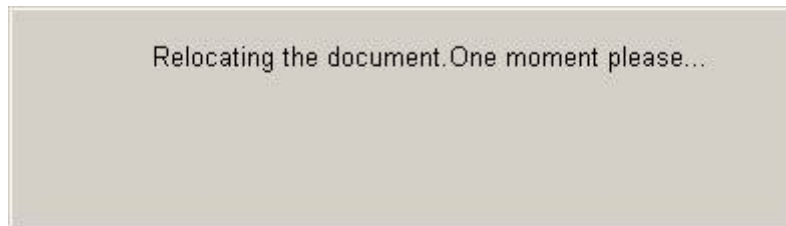
To relocate your e-book, you will see a button with the tool tip stating “Relocate this document”. This icon will appear on the top left corner of your e-book (Highlighted with a blue circle below)



If you click the relocation button (circled in blue) the following screen will appear.



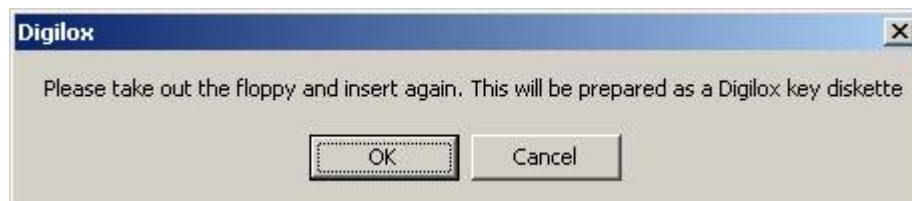
Next you will see on the screen a message that the relocation process has begun.



During the relocation process the following screen may occur.



Insert the Digilox Key (floppy) diskette and press ok
(This step is to validate that you do indeed have a legal copy.)



Remove the Digilox key diskette from floppy drive and reinsert it and press ok.

(You must re-insert the diskette, as the e-book protection system needs to write specific information to your floppy diskette to allow your e-book to be copied to another computer. If this is not done, when you copy your e-book to another computer, the status shown on the floppy will indicate that your e-book is still installed on another computer.)

If the relocation is successful the following screen will appear:



Once the above screen comes you can open the protected ebook on another machine. You will need to do the same process as before (begin at Step 1 in this section to install your e-book on the other computer).
